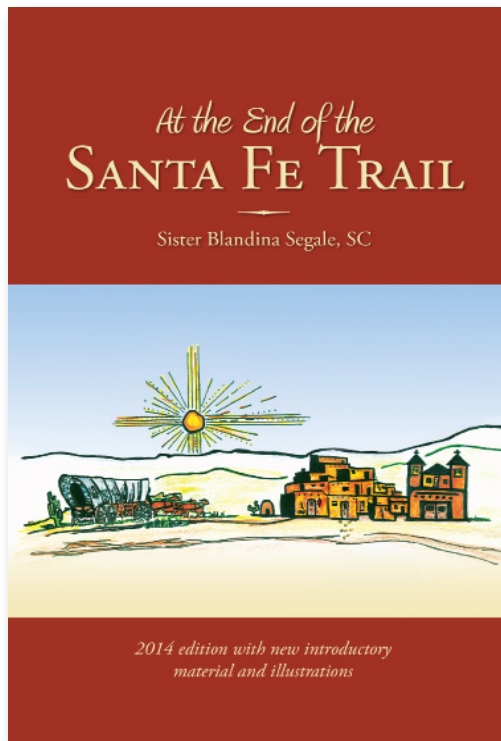


At the End of the Santa Fe Trail
